REGULAR AGENDA – REVIEW/DISCUSS & CONSIDER/ACTION:

1. DISCUSS AND CONSIDER TAKING ACTION RELATED TO FUTURE PLANS FOR AN INDOOR RECREATION FACILITY AND PARTNERSHIP WITH THE YMCA.

Mr. Dunaway presented three items for discussion: 1) to consider the need for an indoor recreation facility; 2) if so, whether or not to consider calling a bond election to fund such a center; and 3) if the City would be interested in pursuing a partnership with the YMCA.

Council Member McDonald made a request to have the YMCA to make their presentation first and respond to questions regarding their proposal. YMCA Board members responded to questions from the Council and Council Member McDonald moved to call a G. O. Bond election in May for \$3 million to construct an indoor recreation facility. Council Member Hill seconded the motion. VOTE: Five voted AYE. Motion passed.
