1. **Consider approving Interlocal Agreement with Williamson County regarding participation in the design and construction related to the SE Loop Construction Project, FM3349 and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement.**

Jeff Jenkins, Deputy City Manager - The County will be constructing within the city limits, therefore, the County has to have approval for design and construction from the City of Taylor.

Motion was made by Councilmember Ariola to approve the Interlocal agreement as presented and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Drummond. Motion carried 4 to 0.

2. **Consider Authorizing the Award of Construction Contract for the FM 973 Water and Wastewater Line Improvements to D. Guerra Construction, LLC.**

Jacob Walker, HDR Engineering - This project provides increases in water distribution and wastewater conveyance in the areas experiencing the most growth, southwest areas of Taylor. Four responsive bid proposals were submitted for constructing the project. D. Guerra Construction, LLC. of Austin, Texas (D. Guerra) is the low bidder.

Motion was made by Councilmember Ariola to accept the bid of D. Guerra Construction, LLC in the amount of \$8,307,365.00 for constructing the FM 973 Water and Wastewater Line Improvements Project. Motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Anderson. Motion carried 4 to 0.
