Call to order and declare a quorum

The meeting was called to order and quorum declared at 5:30 P.M.

Approve the minutes from March 28, 2023

Minutes for March 28, 2023 were approved as presented.

Follow up DAR membership.

Mrs. Komandosky reported on the recent visit by three members of the Georgetown DAR group. They presented the museum with a copy of Miss Mary Moody's certificate of membership and asked that it be displayed along with her DAR pin in the upstairs room devoted to her. They will also be providing us with a copy of Miss Mary's application for DAR membership and her supplemental application listing a second ancestor who had served in the American Revolution.

Discuss & make plans for Pounds of Plenty Event

The upcoming Pounds of Plenty event set for June 24 10 a.m.-noon was discussed.

Terry Pierce offered to take flyers and hand them out at the upcoming Music on Main event. She will also ask downtown merchants to post signs.

Travis Summerlin said that he would ask restaurants here in town to post signs and serve as collection sites.

Susan will contact local banks about helping publicize the event and ask them to serve as collection sites. She will also request participation from Kunisch Wellness Center, the Masons and Baylor Scott & White. Susan will also contact the Chamber of Commerce about publicizing the event. Susan will ask Carrie Orts to contact the Fire and Police Departments and request the barricades and ice from the City.

Marilyn Fleming has spoken with several vendors about setting up on the lawn that day and given them a deadline of June 1 to notify her. If we are to have visitors, then that needs to be publicized in the newspaper and on social media.

Terry Pierce will ask the Blackland Quilters to participate. She will also send the flyers out to local churches.

It was suggested that in the future we have an explanation of the history of the tradition of holding a "pounding" on the back of the flyer and in all publicity.

The Friends of the Moody Museum will provide refreshments. Joe Burgess will see to putting the bunting up and it will remain up through July 4.

Report from the Friends of the Moody Museum

Mr. Burgess said that he had worked with the Williamson Museum to put up a display at the Old Taylor High. The Williamson Museum now has control of those display cases through an agreement with the building's owners. Joe also reported that since this is the 100th anniversary of the Klan trial that he will try to recruit Ken Anderson, author of "Dan Moody, Crusader for Justice," to speak at the museum this fall. That event could be the kickoff of a resumption of our Story Nights.
