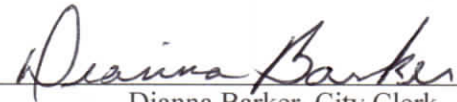

XI, §11, A majority vote is required if the members of a governing body in a city that has increased the terms of office for its elected officials to more than two years, and if the home rule city has a charter provision requiring a majority vote.

At the May 9, 2019 City Council meeting the City Attorney presented the 3 propositions.

On August 13, 2020 City Council adopted Resolution R20-22 ordering the November election and placing the 3 amendments on the ballot.

Art XI, Sec 5, Tx Constitution – a home rule city's charter may not be amended more often than every 2 years.

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY COUNCIL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF TAYLOR, TEXAS ON THE 3rd DAY OF NOVEMBER 2020 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING THREE AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylor, Texas, held an election on November 3, 2020 for the purpose of considering three amendments to the City of Taylor Charter; and

WHEREAS, presiding judges in the election districts and the presiding judge for early voting have certified to the City Council of this City the results of said election; and

WHEREAS, said election returns for said election districts and for early voting have been duly canvassed in accordance with the law and upon consideration of same that said returns were duly and legally made; and

WHEREAS, the official results of votes cast in the Charter amendment election include a total number of 5,842 votes for Proposition A, 5,487 votes for Proposition B, and 5,680 votes for Proposition C, including the following:

PROPOSITION A

Shall Article 4, Section 4.1 of the Taylor City Charter be amended to require that Council members be elected by a majority vote.

FOR: 5,329 **AGAINST:** 513

PROPOSITION B

Shall Article 4, Section 4.2 of the Taylor City Charter be amended to state that a conflict of interest between a Council Member and the City Council shall be defined by Chapter 171 Texas Local Government Code as written or subsequently amended and upon compliance with Chapter 171 the conflict of interest shall be deemed properly disclosed.

FOR: 4,778 **AGAINST:** 709

PROPOSITION C

Shall Article 9, Section 9.1 of the Taylor City Charter be amended to allow the City Manager to hire and remove employees of the City.

FOR: 3,589 **AGAINST:** 2,091

1. PURPOSE/DESCRIPTION

The Police Department and Fire Department are requesting to purchase radios to complete the End of Life Radio Replacement.

2. STAFF ANALYSIS / BACKGROUND / PRIOR COUNCIL ACTIONS

The City of Taylor has been contacted by Williamson County Emergency Services to purchase replacement Police/Fire Radios and be reimbursed by Williamson County through CARES Act Funding. The Police and Fire Department still have radios that are "End of Life" or "Legacy Radios" and need to be replaced with upgraded radios. "End of Life" means that Motorola can no longer guarantee service, support, or replacement parts for radios that have reached their expiration date.

The Police Department is requesting 16 Portable Radios (handheld) for \$89,834.24 and 7 Mobile Radios (in police vehicles) for \$41,702.43 for a total (with discounts) of \$127,796.57. The Fire Department is requesting 5 Portable Radios \$39,459.80 and 2 Mobile Radios for \$14,548.32 for a total (with discounts) of \$54,008.12. The Grand total for the City of Taylor Police and Fire is \$181,804.69.

The full amount of the grand total will be reimbursed to the City of Taylor by Williamson County through CARES Act funding. Included is an assurance letter from Williamson County First Assistant Auditor Julie Kiley confirming reimbursement for \$181,804.69.

The Williamson County Emergency Services Communications System is a Motorola user to include the Williamson County Sheriff's Department, Taylor Police and

Fire Departments, Williamson County Constable's Precincts 1-4, Hutto Police Department, Round Rock Police and Fire Department, Georgetown Police and Fire Department, Liberty Hill Police Department, Leander Police and Fire Department, and Cedar Park Police and Fire Department. Taylor Police and Fire are part of the Williamson County Emergency Services Communications System. The City of Taylor pays a monthly user fee. Both Williamson County and City of Taylor are Motorola based systems, with Motorola software, consoles, mobile, and portable radios. Motorola handles the encryption of channels, set-up, maintenance, support, and replacement if needed.

Motorola is part of the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) purchasing program that assists local governments in reducing costs through this government-to-government procurement service. A purchase under the state contract eliminates any bid requirements. The City of Taylor is receiving the discount amount under the state contract. The purchase will be made under the state's contract with Motorola and therefore the requirement for competitive bids is met.

Police and Fire Portable and Mobile Radios are covered under a 5-year Factory Warranty. After 5 years (which begins upon receipt of equipment), maintenance agreement payments based on the number of Portable and Mobile Radios will be due. This will be an annual payment.

On June 13, 2019, City Council approved the purchase of the Police Department's and Fire Department's needed upgrade to purchase radio replacements with Motorola for the amount of \$600,459.74. The former radio system had reached the end of life. Motorola had sent "Intent to Cancel" notifications.

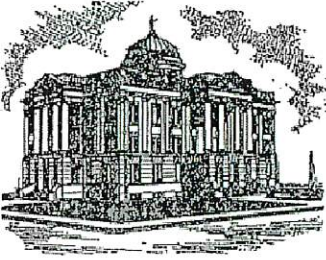

Chief Fluck:

This letter serves the purpose of confirming that Williamson County will reimburse the City for the replacement of Motorola Legacy Radios from the CARES Act funding received by the County.

These radios present a public safety risk for your Police and Fire as they can no longer be repaired and are end of life. They also present a public safety risk to the Williamson County Communications Department when dispatching calls for your agencies. Your agencies are an important aspect of the ongoing response to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

The cost for Police totals \$127,796.57 and the cost for Fire is \$54,008.12 for a total of \$181,804.69. These radios need to be procured by your city, received and programmed by December 30, 2020 in order to be eligible for reimbursement from the CARES Act funding. Our Wireless Department is available to assist with these processes.
