**Call to order and declare a quorum**

The meeting was called to order and a quorum declared at 6:06 p.m.

**Approve the minutes from the June 15, 2010 meeting**

Motion was made by Board Vice Chairman Trey Keith to approve the minutes with the correction that his name is in the Present column but should be in the Absent column for last months meeting. Board Member Bobby Frazier seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**Discuss changing Parks Board meeting time and date**

Motion was made by Board Member Gary Gola to change the date of the Parks Board meetings to Wednesdays and keep the time the same, 6:00 pm, meeting on a monthly basis, starting the new meeting date in August 2010. Board Member Andrew Gonzales seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**Discuss combining Sports Complex rental and attendant fees**

Board Member Jimmy Ellis made a motion to approve the combination of the rental and attendant fees, rounding off the amount to \$70.00. Seconded by Vice Chairman Trey Keith. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**Discuss Tennis Court Resurfacing information presented by Board Member Gary Gola**

Board Member Gary Gola presented the board with a ball park amount of \$2,600 to \$4,000 per court, amounts coming from 2 quotes, courts being unseen by companies providing quotes. Board Member Gary Gola made a motion to recommend to the Council not to destroy the current tennis courts, but to repair them for public use and to secure an answer from the Taylor Independent School district regarding whether the tennis courts, to be built at the new High School on 973, will be available for public use or not. The Board would like the Council to consider seeking grants to build new or repair the tennis courts, either where they are or at the Sports Complex. Gary Gola motioned to take these items to the City Council. Seconded by Board Member Andrew Gonzales. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**Discuss noise ordinance enforcement at the Sports Complex**

Recreation Superintendent Mike DeVito's recommendation to the parks board is to leave enforcement of the noise ordinance up to the tournament leagues and officials. Motion was made by Board Member Andrew Gonzales and seconded by Board Member Jimmy Ellis. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**Discuss pool usage**

Board Member Jimmy Ellis would like to review a cost breakdown for the pools revenue versus maintenance costs. Vice Chairman Trey Keith suggested reviewing these revenues and costs at the end of this years pool season. A recommendation to decrease the number of lifeguards on the days the attendance is low at the pools was suggested by the Board. Item was tabled until end of pool season.

**Identify items for the next meeting**

Board members would like to review cost breakdown such as utilities, soda contract, usage fees, labor, maintenance and attendance records for the Sports Complex (Mike DeVito). Board Member Gary Brock suggested moving from treated water to well water @ the Sports Complex (Mike DeVito)
