Main Highlights

- Local Leagues wrapping up the spring season
- TRP had 4 tournaments in 5 weekends in Aprils
- Rotary concrete water fountains removed
- Repainted mushroom at Doris Pool
- Repaired Splashpads
- Batting Cages are 85% done at TRP
- Concrete is being poured this week at Doak Park
- Doak Park is will open July. Deadline is September
- Tyler showed pictures of new Batting Cages
- Percussion Park is coming along great. Should be complete by late July.

- Irrigation has been checked and working well.
- Dickey Bridge Rehab is safe now. Has a Historical Marker. Funding is being provided by Taylor Conservation & Heritage Society.
- Attendance at TRP was good in April with Revenue \$12,505.
- Staff – 1 Crew Leader / 3 Maintenance Employees. Hiring 2 on Monday
- Rentals for April – Revenue \$2,250
- Men's Softball Tournament at Robinson Ballfield on June 4th with 9 teams.
- It was suggested that we need lighting & sound for the stage at Heritage Square
- Put-Put golf was a good meeting. Some non-profit talk. Still could possibly be done.
- New pool is on the Capital Improvement Plan.
- Asked for Programs Coordinator and full time Admin in next year's budget.
- Civic Rec software will be live soon.

Aquatic Facility Review

- Getting pool ready to run.
- Heritage Splashpad had problems last summer. Over the winter, the other side started sinking.
- Water barrier – having contractor look at it to install additional drains.
- Pool is 22 years old now. Has holes and losing water in upper pool. Two new motors & pumps.
- Pool house office & restroom needs to be replaced. A lot of shifting going on.
- New Trash cans, 4 picnic tables with umbrellas (2 upper / 2 lower)
