Mr. Seaquist presented Council with a draft map considered Plan A and went over a presentation explaining the redistricting laws and process.

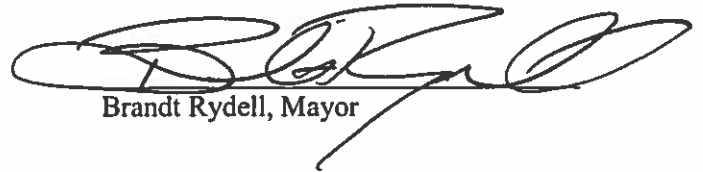
Taylor must do the redistricting process due to being more than 10% deviation. Currently Taylor is at 39% deviation.

This workshop was only discussion. No action was taken.

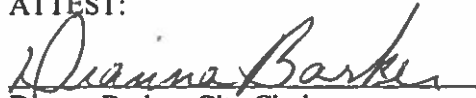
ADJOURN
