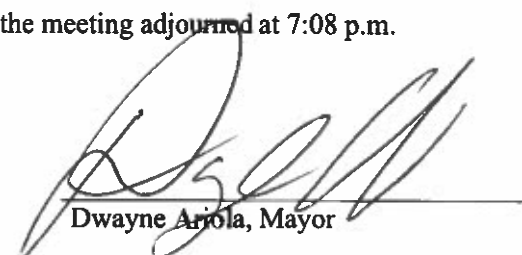
2. **Approve minutes from the March 27, 2025, regular City Council meeting.**
