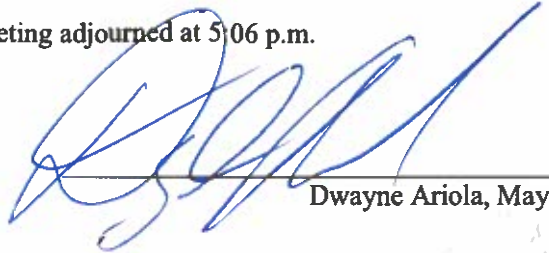

REGULAR AGENDA; REVIEW/DISCUSS AND CONSIDER ACTION

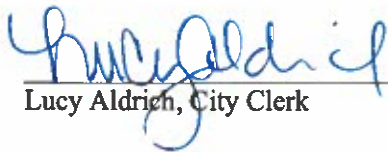
1. **Consider approval of Resolution R25-09 canvassing the results of the May 3, 2025, general election.**
