1. PURPOSE / DESCRIPTION

To consider a resolution canvassing the returns and declaring the official results of the City of Taylor Runoff Election held on June 7, 2025, for the purpose of electing one Council Member from District 4.

2. STAFF ANALYSIS / BACKGROUND / PRIOR COUNCIL ACTIONS

The City of Taylor held a runoff election on June 7, 2025, for the purpose of electing a Council Member for District 4. The election was conducted in coordination with the Williamson County Elections Department in accordance with the Texas Election Code and the City Charter.

The election returns have been verified and certified by Williamson County election officials. State law requires the governing body to officially canvass the election results not earlier than the third day or later than the eleventh day after election day.

The resolution includes the certified results as Exhibit A. Heather Long is declared elected as Council Member for District 4 for a term ending May 2028.

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY COUNCIL RUNOFF ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF TAYLOR, TEXAS ON THE 7TH DAY OF JUNE 2025 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE COUNCIL MEMBER FROM DISTRICT 4.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylor, Texas, held a runoff election on June 7, 2025, for the purpose of electing one person as a member of the City Council from District 4, to serve a three-year term expiring May 2028; and

WHEREAS, presiding judges in the runoff election districts and the presiding judge for early voting have certified to the Williamson County Elections Administrator the results of said election; and

WHEREAS, runoff election returns for said election districts and for early voting have been duly canvassed in accordance with the law, and upon consideration, the City Council finds that said returns were duly and legally made; and

WHEREAS, the canvassed runoff election results for District 4 are as follows:
