### 1. PURPOSE / DESCRIPTION

Review and provide recommendation of approval for the remainder of the Music on Main Fall 2025 season.

### 2. STAFF ANALYSIS / BACKGROUND / PRIOR COUNCIL ACTIONS

Music on Main is a free, family-friendly live music series presented by the City of Taylor to promote community gathering, support local and regional musicians, and encourage economic activity in Downtown Taylor. The concerts are held in Heritage Square (400 N Main Street) on Thursday evenings during the spring and fall seasons. Since its inception, Music on Main has become a signature cultural program that brings together residents and visitors to enjoy live performances while supporting downtown businesses.

The Music on Main program is designed to:

- Provide free, high-quality live music in a safe, welcoming environment.
- Enhance community pride and quality of life.
- Draw visitors and residents into Downtown Taylor to shop, dine, and engage with local businesses.
- Highlight Taylor as a cultural and entertainment destination.
- The program has been hosted successfully for multiple consecutive years, with positive community feedback and growing attendance.
- In Fall 2024, Music on Main featured a diverse range of artists, drawing an estimated 1000 attendees over the course of the season.

Staff has received a curated Fall 2025 lineup to continue the tradition of showcasing a variety of musical genres while maintaining the program’s broad community appeal.

The proposed schedule for the Fall 2025 season includes the following performances and partner activations:

- Thursday, October 16 – Vallejo with Round Rock Ballet Folklórico, paired with the Hecho en Taylor Market
- Thursday, November 20 – All Hat No Cadillac paired with a Twilight Farmers Market highlighting local growers and producers.

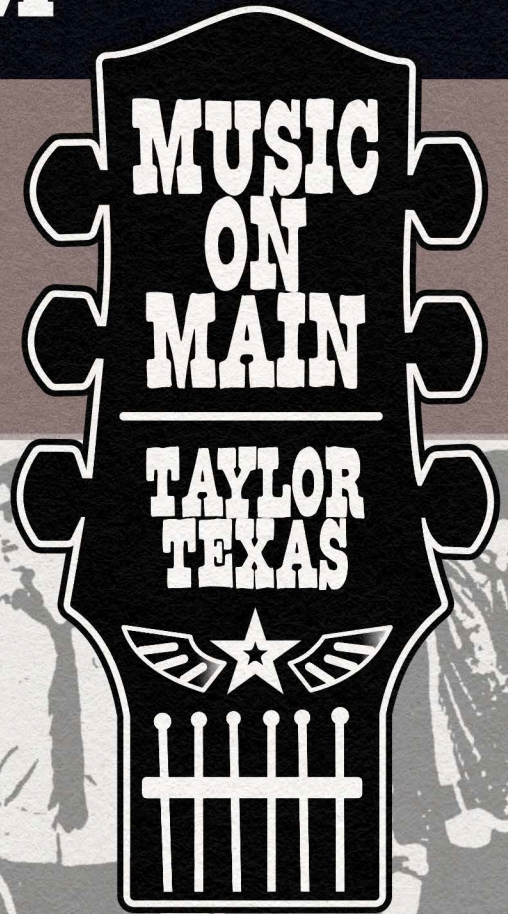

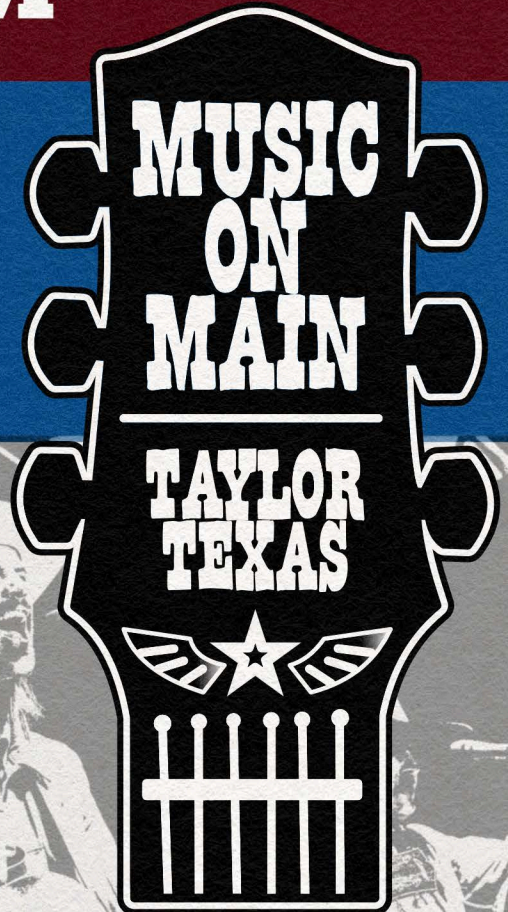
