3. Receive the report from the Friends of the Moody Museum
 - a. Joe Burgess reported that just over \$53,000 for the Dan Moody statue. A selection of the Friends of the Moody Museum went to see the statue at the Foundry. The statue is completed and in storage awaiting a base. Ruby Fisher reported that she would contact Public Works and Internal Services about the installation of the base. There are currently 40 – 8x8” historical bricks and 50 personal bricks. Joe Burgess provided a chart of the wording for the historical bricks. Each line can only be 18 spaces long. It was noted that the Antoose Family donated a Railroad Stock certificate signed by William Taylor – the founder of the City of Taylorsville, later renamed Taylor. It was noted that the fundraising Bricks need to be edited. And that the Moody Advisory Board deserves a brick as well.
4. Discuss and reflect on the Moody Museum’s participation in the Conservation and Heritage Society’s Christmas Tour of Homes
 - a. Participation was not the same as in 2025. Samye Turner noted that the home looked good – and that it was decorated.
5. Discuss and take possible action on the coordination of the Valentine’s Gala to be held on February 12, 2026 from 4 pm – 8 pm

- a. It was noted that furniture will be moved from inside of the Museum to the storage room for the event. That bistro tables will be set up for the event. Ruby has requested 26 white chairs from the event. It was noted that Marcie Svatek has found good volunteers for the day of the event and performers for the event as well. Samye Turner put forward that some of the glass in the server in the dining room would need to be packed and placed elsewhere. It was noted that the board should arrive around 2 pm to host the event.
