2. ADMINISTER OATH OF OFFICE TO COUNCIL MEMBER AT LARGE.

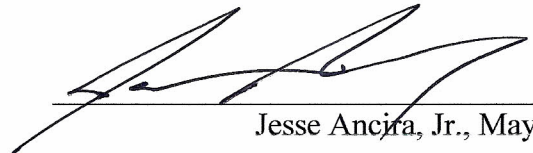
Judge Randall Pick, Taylor Municipal Court, administered the oath of office to Mr. Jesse Ancira, Jr., for the council member At Large.
