1. **Consider approving Resolution R22-16 canvassing the results from May 7, 2022 municipal election.**

District 4 Council Member seat race was cancelled via Resolution R22-10 due to the incumbent, Robert Garcia, having no opponent. Resolution R22-10 also declared Robert Garcia re-elected to office.

*Motion was made by Councilmember Drummond to approve Resolution R22-16 and accept the results from the May 7<sup>th</sup> election as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Garcia. Motion carried unanimously.*

3. **Elect a Mayor.**

Robert Garcia - Yes

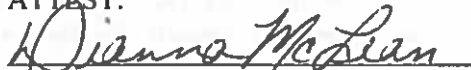
Nomination to appoint Gerald Anderson as Mayor Pro-Tem passed unanimously.

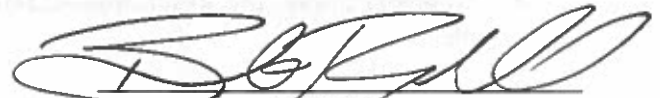
ADJOURN
