Councilmember Garcia nominated Councilmember Anderson.
No other nominations. Mayor Rydell called for a roll call vote.
Councilmember Drummond voted Yes
Councilmember Ariola voted No
Mayor Rydell voted Yes
Councilmember Anderson voted Yes
Councilmember Garcia voted Yes

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Motion carried 4 to 1 appointing Councilmember Anderson as Mayor Pro-Tem.
