RESOLUTION NO. R17-10

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY COUNCIL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF TAYLOR, TEXAS ON THE 6th DAY OF MAY, 2017 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE PERSON AS A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL AT LARGE.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylor, Texas, held an election on May 6, 2017 for the purpose of electing one person as a member of the City Council At Large to serve a three-year term expiring May 2020; and

WHEREAS, presiding judges in the election districts and the presiding judge for early voting have certified to the City Council of this City the results of said election; and

WHEREAS, said election returns for said election districts and for early voting have been duly canvassed in accordance with the law and upon consideration of same that said returns were duly and legally made; and

WHEREAS, the official results of votes cast in the At Large election a total number of 1338 and include the following:

Section 2: The returns of the election have been verified by the presiding judges of the district and by the presiding judge of early voting, and that Dwayne E. Ariola was duly elected as the At Large Council member to serve a three-year term expiring May 2020.
